WHERE TO GET STARTED:

Center for Assessment, Referral & Education (CARE)- Walk-in Monday - Friday from 8AM - 4PM on the 1st floor of the Flag building (room 102B). No appointments given. Provides an assessment and referral plan for students experiencing a variety of mental health concerns and connects students with on-and-off-campus resources. Students seeking Counseling Center or Stamps Psychiatry services must first visit CARE for an initial assessment and referral. 404-894-3498

For After Hours Emergencies

Call the Counseling Center at 404-894-2575 and select option 1 to connect with an after-hours counselor. For on-campus help from the Police call GTPD at 404-894-2500.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Counseling Center - The Counseling Center offers a number of services, including counseling, assessment, consultations, referrals, outreach activities, and workshops. Free for enrolled, degree seeking Georgia Tech students.

Stamps Health Services Psychiatry - Psychiatry provides services to Tech students (including the Language Institute) and their spouses. This includes thorough psychiatric evaluations, therapy referrals and medication management for depression, anxiety, eating disorders, trauma and other mental health issues. All initial assessments are arranged through CARE. The first three hours of treatment are free.

GTPD - Students experiencing urgent mental health related concerns outside of business hours are encouraged to contact the after-hours counselor on call.
